H-DNC names all-league team

In the Big 5, the H-DNC selected co-MVPs, one for offense and one for defense, and not surprisingly both players were from the historic Del Norte team that went undefeated in league for the first time in school history. The Warriors advanced to the second round of the North Coast Section playoffs where they lost to Marin Catholic for their first and only loss of the season.

Taking MVP honors on the offensive side of the ball was wide receiver Garrett Standring, and on defense, it was linebacker Sean Reed.

In the Little 4, Ferndale's senior quarterback Tommy Jorgensen was named MVP as he helped his team once again advance to the NCS championship game where the Wildcats lost in a fourth-quarter comeback to Salesian.

Del Norte had eight of its players selected to the all-league team and four made honorable mention.

Standring, Reed, Rudy Navarro, Nick Cowen, Hans Grant, Kyle Newton, Chad Freeman and Troy Clark made all-league, while Brian Hernandez, Dusty Thomas, Harold Jones and Max Perez made honorable mention.

Tony Xayavong, Terry Gruetzmacher, Brandon Vitale and Matt Richards received honorable mention.

For Fortuna, Collin Humphrey, Zach Anaya, Casey O'Day and Justin Primofiorie made all-league. Miles Callihan, Brandon Chairez, Ryan Riddle, Brian Reid, Ali Cervantes and Dylan Hansen made honorable

mention.
