The following list of student actions constitute violations of the established rules and regulations.

(Mandatory referral for expulsion if victim is district employee.) ○ Persistent harassment, or sexual harassment. ○ Major vandalism to the school bus. ○ Possession of or under the influence of alcohol or other drugs. ○ Possession of a knife, explosive or other dangerous object.
